


YEAR 4 - ANIMALS INCLUDING HUMANS - DIGESTION

decay	natural process of slowly losing health or strength
digestion	the breaking down of food that is eaten
excretion	process of getting rid of faeces, urine or sweat through the
	body.
oesophagus	the part of your body that carries the food from the throat
	to the stomach
stomach	the organ inside your body where food is digested before it
	moves into the intestines
intestines	the tubes in your body through which food passes when it has left your stomach
	part of the digestive system where stools are stored before
rectum	leaving the body through the anus
carnivore	an animal that eats meat
omnivore	an animal that eats plants and animals
herbivore	an animal that feeds on plants
