
Autumn Term 1 in Year 3

English

Our book focus for this half term will be 'Stone Age Boy' and 'The Great Cave'.

Writing lessons will focus on basic sentence punctuation (capital letters and full stops). We will be writing to entertain (description) and to inform (instructions).

Science

Our first science unit is animals including humans. We will explore human and animal skeletons and their functions.

This half term we will focus on place value and addition and subtraction:

Maths


- One more and one less

We will learn about the Stone, Bronze and Iron Ages, focusing on Stone Henge and Skara Brae.
