Our topic for this half term is 'Europe'.

English

Our book focus for this half term will be: 'Fox' by Margaret Wild

Writing lessons will focus on sentence punctuation and developing our vocabulary.

We will be writing to entertain- a story from a character's perspective.

Maths

This half term we will focus on:

- Place value. We will represent and partition numbers up to 10,000. We will be comparing, ordering and rounding numbers.
- Addition and subtraction of 2 four-digit numbers with exchange.

Science

Our first science unit is States of Matter (solids, liquids and gases).



Geography

We will be studying the human and physical geography of Europe with a focus on the Mediterranean and Italy.



Reading

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PSHE

Our unit is 'Me and my Relationships.' We will be learning about bullying, assertive skills and how to recognise our feelings.

DT

We will be evaluating existing pasta sauces and making our own Mediterranean inspired pasta dish. We will be learning safe cutting techniques.

Our unit is Symbolism. We will be studying the symbols of Christianity, Islam and Hinduism.
