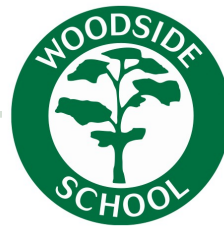

It was a wonderful event, full of fun and community spirit, and it wouldn't have been possible without the hard work and dedication of our amazing parent volunteers. The children had also clearly been practising for the "dunk the Headteacher", as I'm sure their aim was better this year!

Our Year 6 pupils have also made us incredibly proud on their recent residential at Mill on the Brue. Their behaviour was exemplary throughout, and it was heartening to see them supporting one another and rising to the challenges they faced. Whether it was tackling a high ropes course or simply being away from home, they showed great resilience and teamwork. A big thank you as well to the staff who accompanied the trip, your willingness to give up your own time to provide these memorable experiences is so appreciated.

I'd also like to congratulate Year 4 on a fantastic set of results in the Multiplication Tables Check. We achieved some great results, with 82% of children scoring 21+ and 48% achieving full marks! With an average score of 22.8, all of these scores are higher than the national average for last year and are a significant improvement on Woodside's own scores from last year!

Looking ahead, we're very excited about Transition Day next Tuesday. It's always a special moment in the school year as children meet their new teachers and begin to look ahead to the next stage of their journey at Woodside.
