

Year 4

Year 4 visited Ashridge to bring their science and geography learning to life. During the trip, the children explored woodland habitats through a bug hunt, investigating areas such as decaying trees, leaf litter and fallen logs. They discovered a range of invertebrates, including woodlice, beetles and spiders, helping them understand how living things are adapted to their environments. As part of their geography learning, pupils practised using four-figure grid references in a real outdoor setting. Working in teams, they used maps and coordinates to locate checkpoints and solve clues, showing excellent teamwork, problem-solving and map-reading skills. The trip provided valuable hands-on learning and encouraged curiosity, collaboration and respect for the natural world.



Year 5

Year 5 had a fantastic geography fieldwork trip to the River Misbourne, where they investigated how a river changes along its course, the importance of water, and why this location supported early settlement. Pupils sketched and accurately labelled river features, measured the flow rate at different points, and identified evidence of human impact, including the river's historical role in powering the town mill. The children thoroughly enjoyed the experience, made the most of the beautiful weather, and behaved impeccably throughout the day, demonstrating resilience and teamwork as they successfully navigated the long, hilly walk.
