As we approach the end of another busy term, I wanted to share some updates from what has been happening around school recently.

This is our penultimate newsletter of the year, and what a year it has been. There's still plenty happening as we head towards the summer break, with pupils continuing to make the most of every opportunity.

These experiences are so valuable for their personal development and confidence.

Meanwhile, Year 3 had a fantastic trip to West Wittering beach. The pupils had a brilliant time, and I'm sure they came back with plenty of stories to share with their families. These trips are such an important part of school life, giving pupils the chance to explore new places and learn through hands-on experiences.

Year 6 are currently busy preparing for their production of The Wizard of Oz, which will be performed next week. The pupils have been working incredibly hard on their performances, and I know it's going to be a fantastic show. It's always amazing to see how much effort and enthusiasm the pupils put into these productions.

With the hot weather we've been experiencing, please remember to send your children to school with hats and sun cream. It's also important that they bring water bottles to stay hydrated throughout the day. We want to make sure everyone stays safe and comfortable during these warmer days.

I'm delighted to share some excellent news about our Year 6 SATs results. The pupils have achieved amazing results this year. We achieved 85% in Maths, 82% in Reading and 82% in Writing, with 79% of pupils achieving the expected standard in all three subjects. All of these results are significantly above the national average and show a real improvement from last year. The pupils should be incredibly proud of their hard work and dedication. Individual results will be sent home with pupil reports next week.

These results reflect the hard work of our pupils, the dedication of our staff, and the support from families at home. It's a real team effort, and I couldn't be more proud of what we've achieved together.

Finally, Varisha has also Completed her Level 4 in swimming.





