We pride ourselves on achieving great results without high pressure 😊

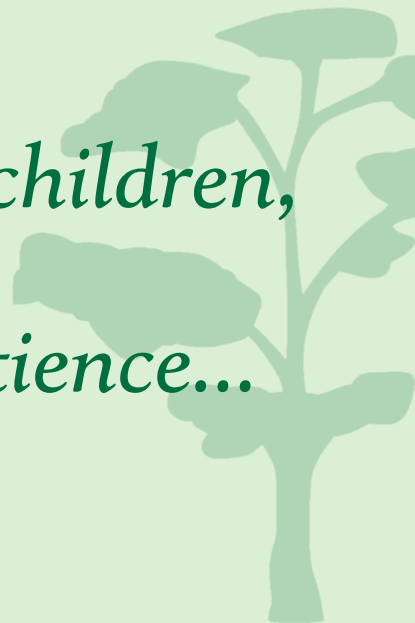
Parent Helpers
