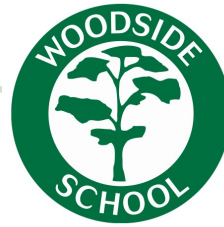

Dear Parents and Carers,

It's been a lovely week at Woodside which has been topped off by some great news about our playground. We have gained approval from the ODBST to resurface our Year 5 & 6 playground! This will now bring it in line with the lower school playground, which was resurfaced last summer. It will improve the drainage and give a much smoother surface for the children to play on. We hope to have the work completed during the summer term, dependent on the contractor dates.

A lot of work goes on in the background to keep our site safe and looking as good as it does. Mr Appleby works incredibly hard on all sorts of different jobs around the school, from helping with computers to completely renovating the toilet areas.
