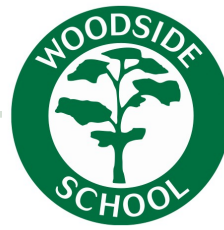

A gentle reminder to book your parents evening slot if you haven't done so already- this is now available via your MCAS account.



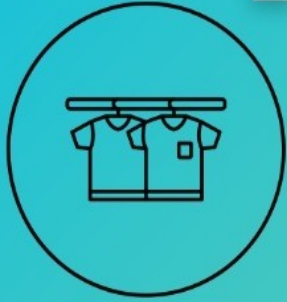
Plea for Tissues!
