Dear Parents and Carers.

It's hard to believe that we've only been back in school a couple of weeks since half term, as we've all been very busy! Yesterday was a great day, which really highlighted what it is

The sight of 120 children joining the Metropolitan line in Amersham must have been a shock to commuters, but we received several comments on how well behaved and respectful our children were. Special thanks to Mrs McCarthy who worked magic and arranged a special deal for our children's train tickets!

Since this half term has started, we've also managed to fit in the Year 5 trip to Oxford Natural History Museum, as well as visits to Amersham and Chalfonts Hockey Club for girls' football training. It's been a busy two weeks that really highlights the offer children receive at Woodside and how hard our staff work to deliver these experiences, which don't happen at all schools!

Year 3 have also participated in a workshop around developing resilience, delivered by the Bucks Mental Health Support Team. These sessions were a great success and the children were equipped with skills to help them when things get a little bit tough.

We've also had Play Leader training for our Y6 Play Leaders. They have been trained in several playground games and given tips on how to support their peers at lunch time. They're supported on occasions by volunteers from Dr Challoner's School, who have now started to volunteer at the school either supporting at lunchtime or by helping in classes. Both of these initiatives are great and really benefit our pupils.

There's always so much going on at Woodside. During our recent open days, Mrs Harrison shared many of the enrichment activities we offer at Woodside with prospective parents. It was incredible just to remind us of the many activities that our children can access and how wide-ranging they are in their topics. We really do try and offer something for everyone!
