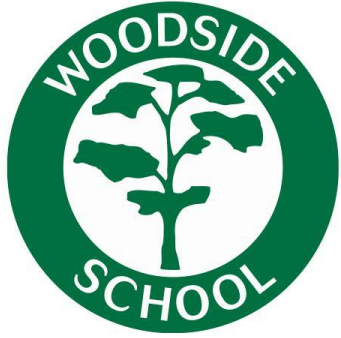

# The School Day

# Uniform

- Skirt or pinafore dress (charcoal grey A line or pleated, knee length)
- Trousers or shorts (charcoal grey school style)
- Shirt (white with top button) and tie OR white polo shirt
- V neck Jumper/Cardigan (bottle green with Woodside Logo)
- Shoes (black school-style shoes. No trainers, shoes with platform soles/high heels, open toe sandals or boots)
- Socks or tights (grey or white socks/grey or bottle green tights)
- Between Easter and October half term – children can wear green checked dresses or playsuits.

# Uniform

## PE Uniform:

- Green Polo shirt with school logo
- Black shorts (football style or cycling shorts - shorts must be long enough they can be seen below their polo shirt)
- White socks
- Trainers
- Jogging bottoms (bottle green or black- **no leggings**)
- PE sweatshirt with school logo (bottle green)

# Uniform

Hair that is past shoulder length must be tied up with either green, white, black or hair coloured hair bands (no large bows or ribbons)

No makeup or jewellery apart from watches and a single small stud earring (must be removed for PE).

# Equipment

Your child will need the following in school everyday

- A fully-stocked pencil case (see next slide)
- School reading book
- Water bottle (named and containing water only)
- Healthy snack for breaktime (fruit or vegetables either fresh or dried or cheese – no cereal bars etc)
- Healthy lunch if they are having a packed lunch
- A rucksack
- Coat/hat as appropriate

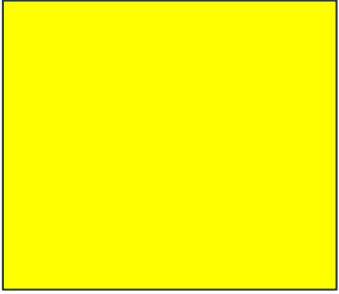
# Pencil case

A **see-through** pencil case containing:

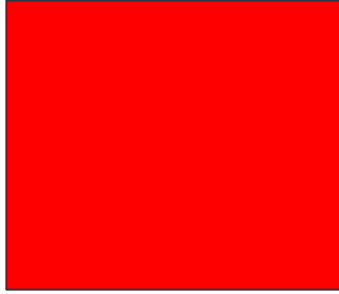
- 2 sharp pencils

- 1 black white board pen
- Yellow highlighter
- Colouring pencils

- Purple biro

- In October, Year 3 will be performing a Harvest assembly to the school and parents

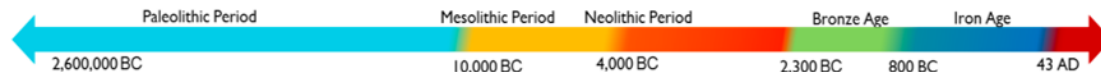
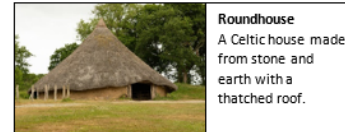
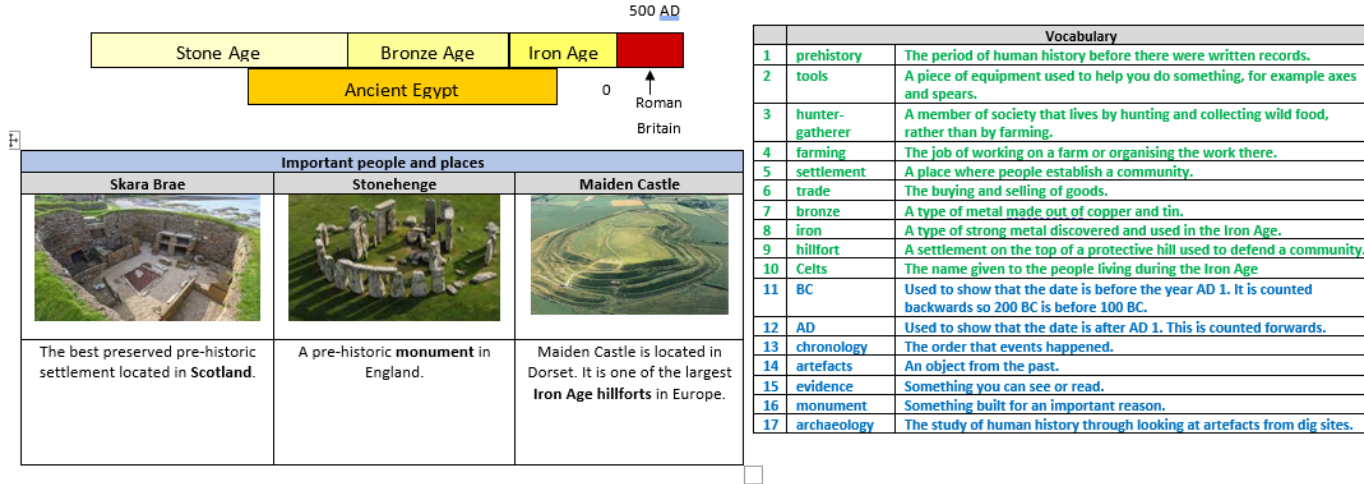
