English

Our book focus for this half term will be 'Stone Age Boy' and 'The Great Cave'.

Writing lessons will focus on basic sentence punctuation (capital letters and full stops). We will be writing to entertain (description) and to inform (instructions).

Maths

This half term we will focus on place value and addition and subtraction:

- Understanding numbers up to 1000
- One more and one less
- Estimating, comparing and ordering numbers
- Add and subtract 2 three- digit numbers with no exchange

Science

Our first science unit is animals including humans.

We will learn about nutrition including food groups and how to have a healthy diet.



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History

We will learn about the Stone, Bronze and Iron Ages, focusing on what life was like and how it changed over this time period.



Reading

Please ensure that all reading is logged on BoomReader a minimum of 3 times a week.

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PSHE

Our unit is 'Me and my relationships'. We will be recognising the relationships we have in our lives and learning how to resolve conflict.

Art

We will be developing our art skills of sketching, painting and colour mixing building up to painting in the style of Mondrian.

RE

Our unit is festivals. We will be exploring how celebrations show what we consider to be important in life.

French

We will be learning different greetings and how to say goodbye to different people in French.

Computing

Children will learn how Google Classroom works and learn basic computing skills. They will also increase their understanding of the keyboard and typing fluency.

Music

We will be focusing on singing in preparation for our Harvest assembly. We will learn the terms 'forte' and 'piano' and sing with actions and movement.
