## **Music listening**

Listening to music is fundamental to musical understanding. By learning to listen to music, pupils are able to expand their musical horizons and also gain a deeper understanding of how music in constructed and the impact it can have on the listener.

Music is one of the central building blocks of any culture and the shared knowledge of music is crucial to cultural capital in understanding where we came from and our place in the world. Our inclusive approach to cultural capital ensures that pupils listen to music from a wide range of cultures and traditions that reflect our community.

We expose children to a wide range of pieces to ensure that pupils gain a broad aural knowledge. These include music from the Western Classical Tradition, classical pieces from the 20<sup>th</sup> and 21<sup>st</sup> centuries, musicals, traditional music from around the world and popular music. We do this both during lesson time and through playing music whilst coming into assembly. During singing assemblies, pupils are taught more about the genre/ artist/ composer being show-cased that week.
